

Child Abuse and Neglect Reporting Act (CANRA):

All LSS Employees must complete the online Child Abuse and Neglect Reporting Act (CANRA) training. California law requires that certain people report known or suspected child abuse. The university has chosen your position as a mandated reporter.

The CANRA training is a **two-step process**.

- The first step, you should have already completed at the Career Center when you agreed and signed the statement acknowledging requirement to report child abuse.
- The second step, is an online presentation that you ALL must complete.

You should be able to log-in and search for the CANRA training. You will need to have your pop-up blocker disabled.
